He is a board member for the Iowa Museum Association and is sits on the governance committee.

Currently, he is bringing focus and awareness of the flourishing visual arts found in the Midwestern United States and is developing international connections using the visual arts. One of these international connections is a community art project through lowa Sister States and the City of Fort Dodge.

In his spare time, Eric enjoys painting, sculpting and writing poetry. As a father of four, his spare time is in short supply, but he enjoys being a father, a husband, and living life to its fullest. He is currently working on several projects, which include a couple of new series of paintings.
